

The Advanced Open Water Course (Adventures In Diving)

- This course is a 'taster' or 'snap-shot' of the many different types of diving available to the recreational diver.
- In this course you will refine your skills, whilst learning new skills suitable for new types of diving experiences.
- It is practical focused, supported by theory components in the manual with knowledge quizzes on each.
- The PADI Advanced Cert. allows you to scuba dive safely to 30m & improve your underwater navigational skills.
- This level of certification is often a requirement for charter boats and those interesting dive sites that are beyond the skills of Open Water Certification level.

<u>Usually completed over one weekend, The Adventures in Diving</u> <u>course includes five dives</u>:

Two of the dives are compulsory:

• Deep and Underwater Navigation

Three dives are elective dives and will typically be derived from the following list:

- Drift
- Night
- Wreck (The boat fee is *not* included in the cost of the course)
- Search and Recovery, or
- Underwater Naturalist
- Boat
- Digital Underwater Photographer
- Marine Fish Identification
- Multilevel
- Peak Performance Buoyancy

The Course Also Includes:

During this course the emphasis is on practical application - with the focus on developing your in-water scuba diving skills.

GENERAL DIVING REQUIREMENTS:

Be a <u>Certified Open Water Diver</u> with PADI or another recognised training organisation.

Fitness: You should have a general level of fitness.

Minimum Age: You must be 15 years or over to complete the course **

**12 to 14 years can qualify for the PADI Junior Advanced Open Water Diver Certification, which may be upgraded to PADI Advanced Open Water Diver Certification upon reaching 15 years. (NB: Max depth for the Deep Dive is 21m for Jnr AOWD)

HOW MUCH TIME DO I NEED & WHEN DO I START?

- The PADI Advanced Diver Course can usually be completed in one weekend. We dive every month, and ALL courses can also be delivered outside of this time at *your* convenience.
- Knowledge Reviews for the dive experiences to be undertaken need to be completed in your own time BEFORE the actual diving commences.



WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

All adventure dives that are completed in the PADI Advanced Course may also count as the first dive of the corresponding Specialty Course. For example, the deep dive which is compulsory, may be counted as Dive 1 of the Deep Diver Specialty Course, which requires a total of four dives.
